Description: Through the generosity of Scouting supporters four scholarships will be presented to high school juniors or seniors, or college students in their freshman year at the Eagle Banquet on Thursday, May 9, 2019.

- (2) - \$3,000 Major General Howard & Bessie McGee Eagle Scout Scholarships
- (1) - \$3,000 Bruce Kennedy Scholarship
- (1) - Robert J. Capps Scoutmaster Scholarship

All Scholarships are to be used for tuition at an accredited college or trade school. For Eagle Scouts in 7th through 10th grades, please wait until your junior or senior year to apply for the scholarship. Scholarships are awarded based on a combination of schooling, service in the community and Scouts, character and need.

Procedure: The Eagle Scout applying for a scholarship must complete the electronic application personally.

- Only one recommendation letter and one transcript must be attached (see requirement #5).
- Be advised that applications become the property of the selection committee and will not be returned to the applicant. By May 7, 2019, the selection committee will notify those selected of its decision. Written notification will not be sent to applicants except those selected.
- Fill out the application form completely and submit via email. Also attach the a) recommendation letter b) transcript with the form and email it to **csharpe@seattlebsa.org** and **copy a parent or guardian.**
- Submitting an application is, in no way, a guarantee that a scholarship will be granted. There is no appeal and the decision of the selection committee is final.
- Only those applications received by **Tuesday, April 23, 2019** will be considered.
- **NO paper applications please.**

Requirements:

All applicants must:

1. Have been granted the Eagle Scout rank.
2. Submit applications online by Tuesday, April 23, 2019.
3. Be a high school junior or senior, or in freshman year of college.
4. Have demonstrated leadership ability in Scouting and a strong record of participation in activities outside of Scouting.
5. Attach one signed recommendation letter from a volunteer or professional Scout leader who knows the applicant personally. This letter should attest to the general character of the applicant. **Endorsements from teachers, counselors, etc. will not be considered.**
6. **Attach a copy of the applicant's high school transcript.**
