## Camp Information

**Check-in and Check-out:** The program starts at 10:30 a.m. on Friday. When you arrive, check in with the camp director. **Bring your health history forms and activity roster** with you. Camp ends at 4:00 p.m. on Saturday.

**Meals and Housing:** Participants will sleep in tents or patrol shelters. No mattresses are provided. Lunch and dinner on Friday and breakfast and lunch on Saturday will be provided.

**Leadership:** In accordance with BSA policy, at least two adults must accompany your group. One leader must be at least 21 years of age. The other may be 18.

### Refunds

Deposits are not refundable unless a unit or camper cannot be placed in the camp or dates chosen. In the event of accident, illness, or **extreme** extenuating circumstances, refunds of **up to 50%** of camp fees may be made if requested in writing at least 15 days prior to your scheduled arrival at camp. 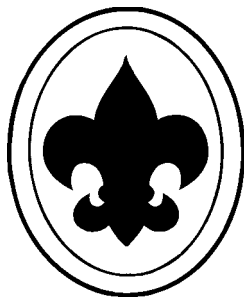
**Insurance:** Each participant must be covered by unit accident insurance. This coverage is not provided by camp. Your ward will have the policy number.

## Directions to Camp Brinkley

From Seattle take I-405 N to Hwy 522. Take Hwy 522 East to its end at the stoplight where it intersects Hwy 2 in Monroe. Turn LEFT onto Hwy 2 and drive about 3/4 mi. A Safeway and McDonalds will be on your left. Turn LEFT onto Woods Creek Rd. Continue about 10.3 mi. Every time there is a fork in the road KEEP RIGHT. Turn RIGHT onto S. Lake Roesiger Rd. At the general store (about 2.5 miles) turn RIGHT onto Monroe Log Camp Rd. In about 1.5 mi. keep RIGHT at the Camp Brinkley/Cascade Scout Reservation sign and proceed to parking lot on the right.



## Directions to Camp Parsons

**From Seattle** take the ferry to Bainbridge Island. Follow Hwy 305 to Hwy 3. Turn right on 3 and go to the Hood Canal Bridge (Hwy 104) and take the Quilcene exit. Turn right off the exit ramp toward Quilcene. Go through Quilcene and head south on Hwy 101. Eight miles past Quilcene, turn left on Bee Mill Rd. at the Shellfish Laboratory sign. Camp is 3/4 of a mile down the road. (2 hours required).
