- File a National Scout Jamboree Personal health & Medical Record before the pre-jamboree training.
- Complete Youth Protection Training.
- Be approved by the local council.
- Be flexible and a team player
- Although not required, *Wood Badge* and/or *Scouter's Key* are desirable qualifications.

FIRST ASSISTANT SCOUTMASTER:

- Same qualifications as Scoutmaster.

SECOND ASSISTANT SCOUTMASTER:

- Be at least 21 years of age by July 1, 2017.
- Serve actively in an adult troop leadership position for at least one year during the three-year period prior to July 1, 2010.
- Serve as a role model of physical fitness.
- Participate in the prejamboree training experience.
- File a National Scout Jamboree Personal health & Medical Record before the pre-jamboree training.
- Complete Youth Protection Training.
- Be flexible and a team player
- Be approved by the local council

THIRD ASSISTANT SCOUTMASTER:

- Be at least 18 years of age (but not 21) by August 4, 2017.
- Have served actively in a troop leadership position.
- Serve as a role model of physical fitness.
- Participate in the prejamboree training experience.
- File a National Scout Jamboree Personal health & Medical Record before the pre-jamboree training.
- Complete Youth Protection Training.
- Be flexible and a team player
- Be approved by the local council
