More About Camp

Kayaking/Canoeing:

Camp Parsons is one of only a handful of Boy Scout camps operating a saltwater aquatics program. Its location on Puget Sound provides outstanding canoe or kayak treks. Scouts paddle along the shores of the Hood

Canal, experiencing unmatched scenery and wildlife while meeting the challenges of navigating and planning, wind, weather and tide.

Hiking:

Camp Parsons is located near some of the best hiking trails in the

Northwest, many developed or first hiked by Scouts from the camp. Depending on the trip the group chooses, you will be hiking 35-50 miles in 5 days. There will be opportunities for cross country treks, day hikes from a base camp, and times to relax in your trail camp or go fishing.
