All Scholarships are to be used for tuition at an accredited college or trade school. For Eagle Scouts in 7th thru 10th grades, please wait until your junior or senior year to apply for the scholarship. Scholarships are awarded based on a combination of schooling, service in the community and Scouts, character and need.

Procedures:

The Eagle Scout applying for a scholarship must complete the application personally.

- Enclose only those items requested in the requirements. Items must not be attached to the application.
- Answer all questions on the application form.

- Be advised that only those applications postmarked before midnight April 19, 2011 will be considered.
- Be advised that applications become the property of the selection committee and will not be returned to the applicant. By May 12, 2011, the selection committee will notify those selected of its decision. Written notification will not be sent to applicants except those selected.
- Submitting an application is, in no way, a guarantee that a scholarship will be granted. There is no appeal and the decision of the selection committee is final.
- All applications must be printed or typed. **If you are using the "fill in" PDF form, please type your application, take a print out and send it in with all attachments.**

Requirements:

All applicants must:

1. Have been granted the Eagle Scout rank (or verify their application for Eagle has been received at the national office).
2. Submit applications before midnight April 19, 2011.
3. Be a high school junior or senior.
4. Have demonstrated leadership ability in Scouting and a strong record of participation in activities outside of Scouting.
5. Provide one signed recommendation letter from a volunteer or professional Scout leader who knows the applicant personally. This letter should attest to the general character of the applicant. **This is the only endorsement required. Endorsements from teachers, counselors, etc. should not be included and will not be considered.** Also provide high school transcript (photocopy is acceptable).
