## More About Camp

Located on a small lake amid thick forest, Camp Brinkley is the ideal spot for Cub Scouts and their leaders to experience Cub Scout camp at its best. Activities include boating and swimming, archery and BB gun ranges, crafts, nature hikes, advancements, campfires and more. Sleeping at camp is either in tents with wooden floors or in Adirondacks (3-sided shelter) on wooden bunks. Each campsite is equipped with rustic bathroom facilities. Showers are centrally located. The trading post offers souvenirs, snacks, drinks, supplies and Scout products.

### How to Register

You may register as a group of Cub Scouts or Webelos made up of boys from your pack or with other packs, or as a parent/child team. No non-Scout siblings allowed in camp overnight. Unit insurance information is required for out-of-council packs. Campsites may be requested, but staff reserves the right to make assignments based on available space and which campsite is appropriate for your group. **The medical form Parts A,B & C is required for all Scouts & adults.**

Fees: \$185/Scout & \$105/Adult. A minimum \$15/person nonrefundable deposit is required to secure a reservation. Deposits are transferrable. Your registration can be mailed to us, or you can call and reserve with credit card at 206-725-0361.
