

## **2012 MOM & ME CAMP INFORMATION**

### **Reservations**

The cost is \$50 per person. Reservations are made through the Camping Department on a first come, first served basis. More than one Scout can now register with their mom. Dens and packs are encouraged to sign up together but a completed registration form is required for each pair.

### **Check In**

Be sure to have breakfast before coming. Plan to arrive before 9:00 am on Saturday. The program kicks off promptly at 10:00 am. When you arrive, you will check in at the main lodge and meet your host. Please have ready a roster of your participants and medical forms. (Medical forms must be kept with the unit leader.) You will then be guided to your cabin and meet your fellow cabin mates.

### **Check Out**

If you leave camp for any reason during your stay, check out at the lodge. Camp ends at 10:00 am on Sunday.

### **Be Prepared!**

The parking lot is small. Carpool as much as you can. No vehicles are allowed past the parking lot. You will need to pack your gear about 100 yards to your cabin.

## **Refunds**

Fees are nonrefundable except in cases of illness or extreme extenuating circumstances. Up to 50% of camp fees may be refunded within 15 days before camp with proper proof of such circumstances. All refund must be emailed to [campingdept@seattlebsa.org](mailto:campingdept@seattlebsa.org) and received no later than 30 days after the date of camp (include unit number, name of person not attending and the reason).

**Refunds are not made at camp.**

## **More About Camp**

Located in the foothills of Mt. Rainier, Camp Sheppard Mom & Me Camp is a great experience at a premier outdoor facility. The camp is specifically designed to build confidence and outdoor skills in a fun and safe environment.

Throughout the day, Scouts will participate in archery, BB gun shooting, crafts, games, adventure course, skit training, nature activity and outdoor learning. Between and after rotations, meals are served in the dining hall. The schedule also features a campfire, chapel service and Polar Bear hike to a scenic location.

Camp Sheppard's nine heated cabins each sleep up to 24 people in bunks with mattresses. Restrooms with showers are centrally located and meals are served in a mountain lodge. The trading post will be open with camping supplies, souvenirs, healthy snacks, candy, pocket knives and other items.

**All Boy Scouts of America policies regarding camp activities must be strictly observed. Alcohol is prohibited. Smoking is permitted in the parking lot only.**

## **Directions to Camp**

**From Seattle:**

**Take I-405 to Renton. Take Hwy. 169 exit (Maple Valley Hwy). Follow Hwy 169 through Maple Valley and Black Diamond to Enumclaw. Turn left in Enumclaw onto Hwy 164. This will lead into Hwy 410 at a light just beyond downtown Enumclaw. Go out Hwy 410 to 1/2 mile past milepost 52 and turn left into camp at the forest service Camp Sheppard sign (Forest Service Road #7155).**
