More About Camp

Founded in 1919, Camp Parsons sits on 440 acres of forested land on Hood Canal, with traditional Scout camp activities such as rifle shooting, archery, climbing tower and advancement classes, as well as canoeing, sailing and swimming in an open salt water aquatics area. The Fort Duckabush Museum catalogs the long, storied history of this well-loved camp. Camp Parsons' beautiful setting, along with its outstanding staff from all parts of the Pacific Northwest and United States, provide a uniquely special experience for Scouts and their leaders.
