

Summer Camp POLICIES and PROCEDURES

Things to remember when signing up for summer camps. Please read carefully and sign the space provided on the front of this form.

1. *Deposits and Fees*

A \$120 deposit is required to reserve space for your troop at summer camp. Fees for 2009 will be \$205 per Scout and \$110 per paying adult for troops in the Chief Seattle Council. Out-of-council troops will pay \$215 per Scout and \$120 per paying adult. The unit will be responsible for making timely payments for the January, March, and May installment dates. 2. *Refunds*

The refund policy appears in full in the *Camp Leaders' Guide*. In summary, **the \$120 deposit is non-refundable, unless the council cannot place you in the camp or site desired.** The remainder of the fees *may* be refundable as stated in the refund policy and requests *must* be made in writing.

3. *Leadership Requirements*

Each troop must have two adult leaders, 24 hours per day, while in camp. Scoutmasters must be at least 21 years of age, assistants at least 18 years of age.

4. *Medical Information*

The Class I & II medical forms require physical exams by a medical doctor every three years, with parental health statements updated every year. All youth and all adults under 40 use the Class I&II Medical Form. Adults over 40 use the Class III Medical Form, which requires an annual physical exam.

5. *Insurance*

Camp does not carry health and accident insurance. Each unit is required to obtain its own coverage for Scouts attending camp. Carrier, policy number, and expiration date must be submitted before the first Friday in April to confirm site reservation.

6. *Troop Size*

Please do not overestimate attendance on this form. Please remember, summer camp is for the youth. Large numbers of adults reduces the number of Scouts attending our camps. Use wisdom as you plan your adult participation. The council reserves the right to change your camp site if needed to accommodate additional campers.

8. *T-Shirts*

A camp t-shirt is awarded to each boy whose troop participated in an approved work party by June 1, 2009 at any of the council camps (Brinkley, Pigott, Parsons or Sheppard).
