

Summer Camp POLICIES and PROCEDURES

Things to remember when signing up for summer camps. Please read carefully.

1. *Deposits and Fees*

A **\$125** deposit is required to reserve space for your troop at summer camp. Fees for 2010 will be **\$215** per Scout and **\$115** per paying adult for troops in the Chief Seattle Council. Out-of-council troops will pay **\$225** per Scout and **\$125** per paying adult. The unit will be responsible for making timely payments for the January, March, and June installment dates. For more information please visit our website www.seattlebsa.org or call the camping department at (206)725-0361.

2. *Refunds*

The refund policy appears in full in the *Camp Leaders' Guide*. In summary, **the \$125 deposit is non-refundable, unless the council cannot place you in the camp or site desired.** The remainder of the fees *may* be refundable as stated in the refund policy and requests *must* be made in writing.

3. *Leadership Requirements*

Each troop must have two adult leaders, 24 hours per day, while in camp. Scoutmasters must be at least 21 years of age, assistants at least 18 years of age.

4. *Medical Information*

Starting January 1, 2010, the Annual Health and Medical Form will be required. For resident camps, all camp participants must have a yearly physical and their form filled out by a health professional. The new forms are available on our website, seattlebsa.org under Council Camping.

5. *Insurance*

Camp does not carry health or accident insurance. Each unit is required to obtain its own accident coverage for Scouts attending camp. Carrier, policy number, and expiration date must be submitted to confirm site reservation.

6. *Troop Size*

An approximate estimate of the number scouts is fine, as long they are finalized by your June payment. Please remember, summer camp is for the youth. Large numbers of adults reduces the number of Scouts attending our camps. Use wisdom as you plan your adult participation. The council reserves the right to change your camp site if needed to accomodate additional campers.

8. *T-Shirts*

A camp t-shirt is awarded to each boy whose troop participated in an approved work party by June 1, 2010 at any of the council camps (Brinkley, Pigott, Parsons or Sheppard).
